Principal's Messages

Dear families,

Welcome to Term 4. It is good to be back and for us all to have some certainty about when we can all be together onsite for school. I appreciate the patience of our school community in following the COVID Safe Return processes that we have been given by the Dept. Of Education. We are a large school of over 550 students with 25 classes K-6 including our Support Classes and more than 60 staff members. Applying the new protocols to our school setting is not an easy task and we understand that it presents many challenges for students, families, and staff onsite.

A few of the key implications for MPS:

- students and teachers will be in separate stage-based groups
- students and teachers in these groups are not to mingle or interact during the school day onsite
- student groups will have separate play spaces and break times
- staff groups will have separate staff rooms and limitations on meetings
- sadly, many of the activities we would like to have done for students are not yet allowed such as camps or excursions

Recently restrictions changed that allowed schools to have Kindergarten Orientation onsite for students so our planning for that is almost complete and families will be contacted very soon with details. If you, or someone you know is planning to enrol in Kindergarten at MPS in 2022 please contact the office as soon as possible so you don't miss out on this important aspect of school readiness. We already have over 50 children enrolled for kindergarten next year.

This week is mental health week and I hope that everyone is actively looking after themselves in this area. This year has been a particularly stressful time for everyone, and we all need to have some strategies to do 'self-care' both physically and mentally. Please remember to access the support materials that our school counsellor has posted onto our website as they are available for everyone in our school community.

I can confirm to you that all staff coming onsite will be fully vaccinated to do so.

Community Messages

Dept. Of Education NSW COVID Safe Protocols for Schools When students and staff return to school:

- masks are always required for all staff.

Cleaning Daily

There will be cleaning daily as students return to school. High touch areas example handrails, door handles, benches and tables will receive extra attention multiple times across the school day.

Clean Classrooms

Our classrooms are cleaned every day, as usual, and we will continue to have hand sanitizer and anti-bacterial wipes in all rooms to help keep everyone healthy.

Bell Times

Dept. Of Education rules for full onsite return require schools to separate cohorts of students. For MPS that will be stage groups: Kindergarten, Stage 1 (Yr.1 & 2), Stage 2 (Yr.3 & 4), Stage 3 (Yr.5 & 6), Support Classes (Multicat & Jnr IO). Our cohorts will have separate play times and separate play areas across the school day. Morning bells (8.30am & 8.45am) and afternoon bells (3.00pm & 3.10pm) will remain the same.

Drop off/Pick up

Dept. Of Education protocols require us to stagger exit from school to prevent/minimise interaction of cohort groups. Stay tuned.......Parents will....... We understand the challenges in following the guidelines given to us to follow and appreciate your patience. Drop off times & gates for each cohort group will be published via Skoolbag & Facebook on Friday.

Parent/Carer onsite

Currently no parents/carers are permitted onto school grounds. Parents dropping off/picking up Support Unit students via the carpark must not enter school grounds & must be wearing a mask when outside of the vehicle. Phone call meetings can be arranged with teachers via the office as needed.


Uniform Shop
